



HOW DO I COMPLETE IT?

The application contains questions that may need to be answered by other parties within your organisation, including your information security, general counsel, privacy, and finance teams.



step 1: As the risk manager, start by selecting the coverage(s) sought and complete the Exposure and Applicability questions. Save the PDF and send it to the appropriate party to answer the next section.

STEP 2: Answer additional questions that populate, in order of priority, based on your prior responses. Some questions will be required (marked with a red asterisk) and some optional. Questions with a gold star, while not required, have a strong impact on your risk scoring.

STEP 3: Sign the completed application using the eSignature function within the PDF (no need to print and sign by hand) and digitally send it to your broker, who will submit it to AIG.



AIG may be able to make assumptions on unanswered questions. Despite the benefits of completing the full application, including policy terms that match your risk more closely, you can still receive a quote based upon answers to only the minimum required questions.

WHAT'S NEXT?



Following the submission of your application and assuming you provided an email for reporting, access your **Summarised Assessment Report (SAR)**, which provides a high level view of your cyber maturity, in the AIG Cyber Portal.

Upon purchasing coverage, access your **Executive Summary Report (ESR)** from the Portal. ESRs are updated monthly and provide an in-depth, detailed analysis of your cyber maturity. Our Cyber Risk Consultants are also available to review these with clients.
